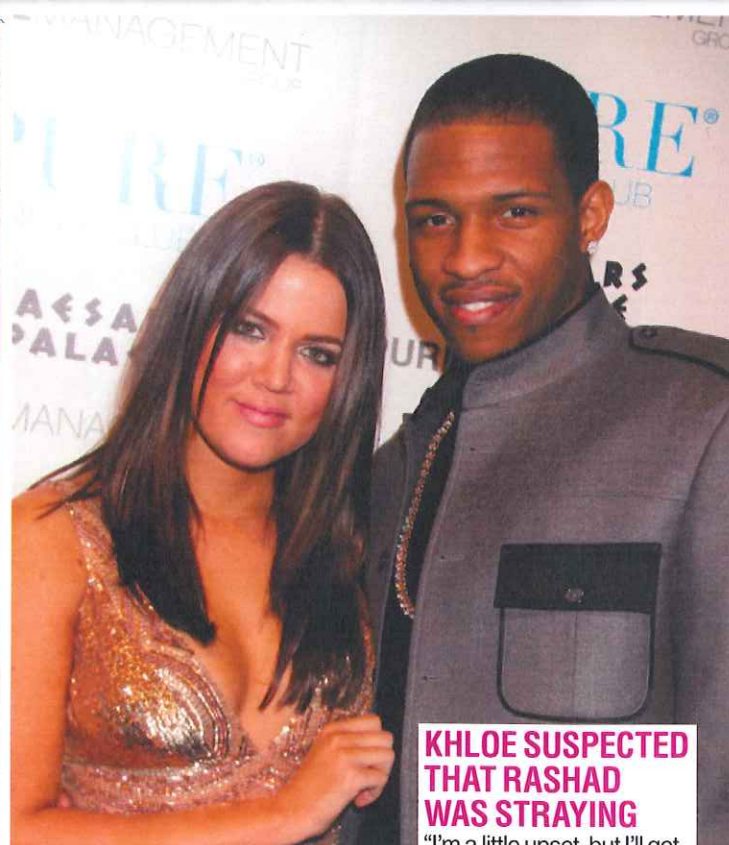


SCOTT'S FLIRTING DROVE KOURTNEY AWAY
